Data can be viewed at any time to allow for 'real time' verification of time or attendance. Extremely versatile, clocks can be accessed on the local network or via the Internet¹ for remote locations. The time recorder can be used as either a wall-mount or as a desktop device . An excellent viewing angle is provided in both orientations by rotating the unit 180 degrees.
